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# SIZING GUIDE

## RINGS

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Would you like to give a beautiful gift or find your own ring size?

The most accurate method is to consult our team in-store (8 rue des Batignolles, Paris 17) or visit any other traditional jeweler. However, if you can't make it to a jeweler, here's a brief guide to help you determine your ideal ring size.

1. Take a piece of ribbon or string and wrap it around the base of your finger. To find your perfect size, we also suggest measuring your finger at the joint.
2. Use a pen to mark where the ribbon or string overlaps.
3. Measure the marked length in centimetres using a ruler.
4. Refer to the third column of the table labeled "Finger circumference in cm."

### \*\*Our Recommendations\*\*

- Measure your finger at the end of the day.
- Keep in mind that one hand is often stronger than the other. If you're right-handed, the fingers on your right hand are stronger than those on your left, and vice versa.
- Our thick ring models (such as Hyacinthe and Olympe) run small, so we advise sizing up.

Our rings are available in sizes 50 to 58.
